ROS is close to home

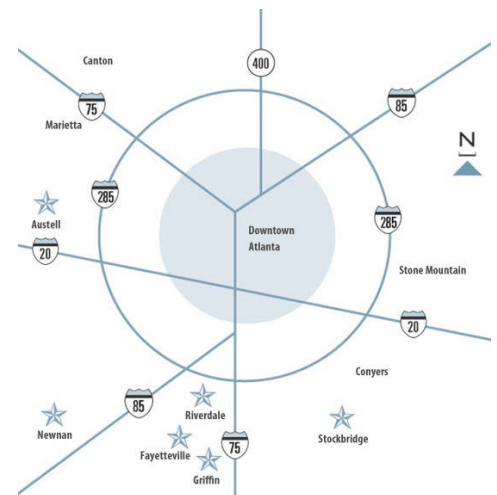
